

The Top Slots Cup is a HOPRA Clubs, team based competition, whereupon any HOPRA club can put forth 3 drivers which must include 2 pros & 1 amateur. Drivers must come from the same club or geographical region to be on a team (i.e, if you're from the West region, you can't race on a North-East region or Central region Team). Also, major clubs in the same general geographic area cannot share drivers (i.e, MAHOPRA can't race with MARC and vice versa). This competition is designed to promote a friendly competition between clubs, as well as introduce more amateurs to our competition.

Any HOPRA club can put forth 3 drivers which, again, must include 2 pros & 1 amateur. Each pro driver on the team has their 2 best race place finishes recorded, and the amateur driver has their best race finish recorded. The total points of all 3 drivers will be counted towards the Cup. This means there are 5 total race finishes counted for each team, 2 for each Pro driver and 1 for the Amateur. The lowest score wins the award. Only national championship classes (including amateur super stock) count towards the cup. Support races do not count towards the points calculated for this award.

Each club can put forth multiple teams!!! Drivers can only be on one team. Each team's members need to be declared before the first national championship class starts racing. Register your team(s) at the registration desk when you arrive. Check the National Championship schedule at www.hopra.net for race dates.
